

## **Module Registration Guidance for First Year Students of Film Studies and French** **– 2023-24**

Welcome to the School of Languages, Linguistics and Film (SLLF), here at Queen Mary University of London.

As a new first year student of Film Studies and French your 120 credits of modules are core/compulsory, meaning you do not have any optional module choices to make.

All students must take 120 credits (including your core/compulsory modules), over two semesters (Semester A: September – December and Semester B: January – April).

### **Your Modules**

As a first year student, you are required to take the following core/compulsory module(s):

- Depending on your language level, you will be placed onto **ONE** of the following:
  - FRE4204 Introductory French [Beginners] (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
  - FRE4202 French Intensive [Post GCSE] (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
  - FRE4200 French I [Post A-Level] (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- SML4006 Culture and Language (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- FLM4205 Decolonising Approaches to Film Analysis (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- FLM4204 US Cinema: Key Concepts (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
