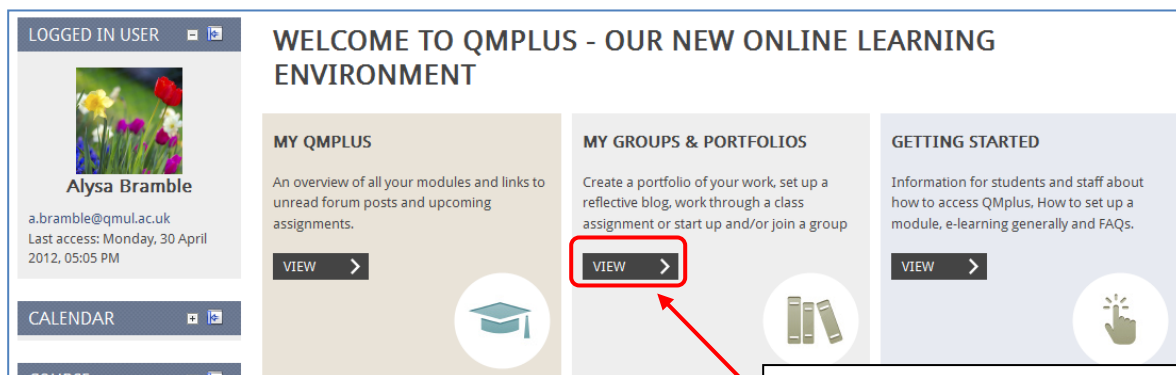


Join the QMplus Users Group!

Six easy steps to join the QMplus Users group:

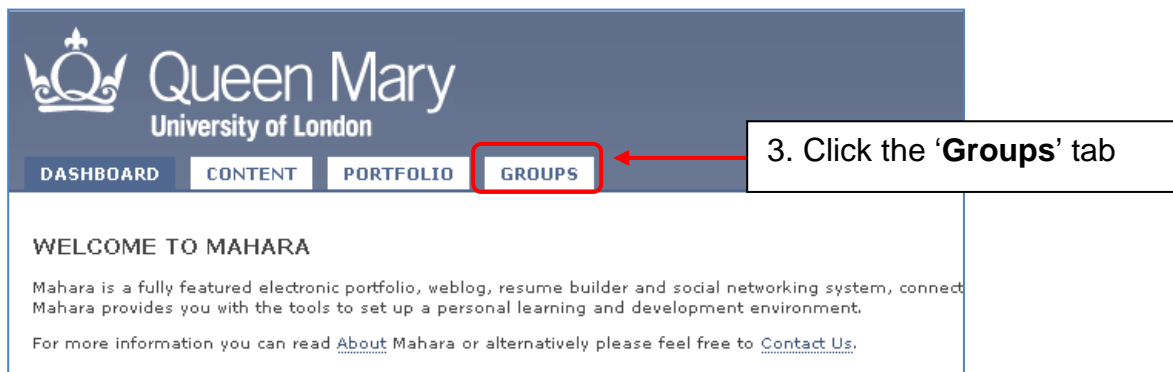
1. Log into QMplus at: <http://qmplus.qmul.ac.uk>
2. Once logged in, click '**View**' within the '**My Groups and Portfolios**' section



2. Log into QMplus and click '**View**' within the '**My Groups and Portfolios**' block.

This will take you into the Mahara Groups and Portfolios section of QMplus

3. Click the '**Groups**' tab from the top menu



3. Click the '**Groups**' tab

This will first show you all the groups that you are already a member of, if any.

4. Click on the '**Find Groups**' link in the left menu
5. Type '**QMplus**' in the Search box and click the '**Search**' button

4. Click on the 'Find Groups' link.

5. Type 'QMplus' in the search box, then click the 'Search' button.

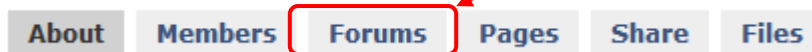
Post a question or read current discussions...

Once you have joined the QMplus Users group you can connect with others members, access Forums and/or share your own experience and files.

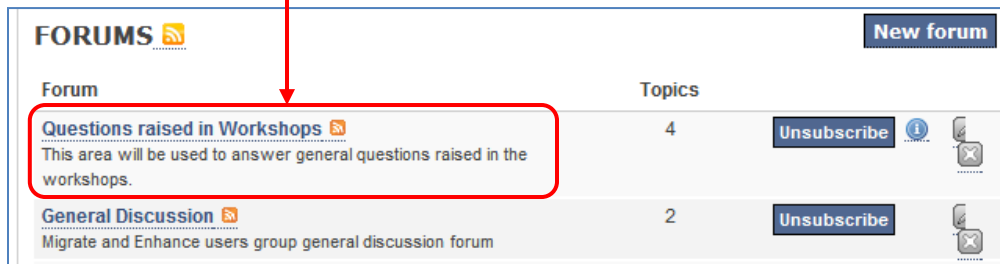
To post a question or see what others are discussing:


1. Click the **'Forums'** tab
